

GESTION A.D.L. (S.E.N.C.) WEBSITE USE POLICY

1. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

This Website is the sole and exclusive property of Gestion A.D.L. (s.e.n.c.), hereinafter referred to a "ADL".
